The Ouachita Council of Governments meeting was called to order by Mayor Jamie Mayo, Chairman. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the Monroe Government Plaza.

**Minutes**

A motion was made by Mr. James Bennett and seconded by Ms. Juanita Woods to approve the minutes of the April 24, 2018 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mayor Norris and seconded by Ms. Juanita Woods to recess the OCOG meeting and go into Long Term Recovery Executive Board. Motion carried unanimously.

**Long Term Recovery Executive Board - (Actions Requested)**

**A. LOGO Approval**

Mr. Doug Mitchell stated before you is a copy of the Ouachita Strong Resiliency Strategy LOGO that is being proposed for the Long Term Recovery. He is asking the board to approve the LOGO.

A motion was made by Ms. Juanita Woods and seconded by Mayor Dave Norris to approve the LOGO. Motion carried unanimously.

**B. New Recovery Manager Approval - (Tom Malmay).**

A motion was made by Mayor Dave Norris and seconded by Mr. Bennett to approve Ms. Courtney Hornsby as the replacement to the Steering Committee of West Monroe.

Mr. Crosby briefly updated the board regarding the Steering Committee May's Report, he also, mentioned meeting dates and locations.

Ms. Juanita Woods asked for a copy of the Steering Committee members.

A motion was made by Mayor Dave Norris and seconded by Mr. Bennett to reconvene OCOG Meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mayor Norris and seconded by Mayor Mayo to ratify the action of the Long-Term Recovery Board. Motion carried unanimously.

**Approval of the 2018-2019 OCOG Budget**

Mr. Doug Mitchell gave a brief report on the OCOG budget, he mentioned in the public review comment period, there was a small change with FTA Portion of the budget. He stated there is a \$306.00 dollar's difference in FTA money. In FY- 2018, FTA total was \$66,702, and FY- 2019 FTA totals are \$ 66,396.

A motion was made by Mayor Dave Norris and seconded by Mr. Bennett to approve the FY-2018-2019 OCOG budget. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mayor Dave Norris and seconded by Ms. Woods to recess the OCOG meeting and go into Transportation Policy Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **A. TIP Amendment**
