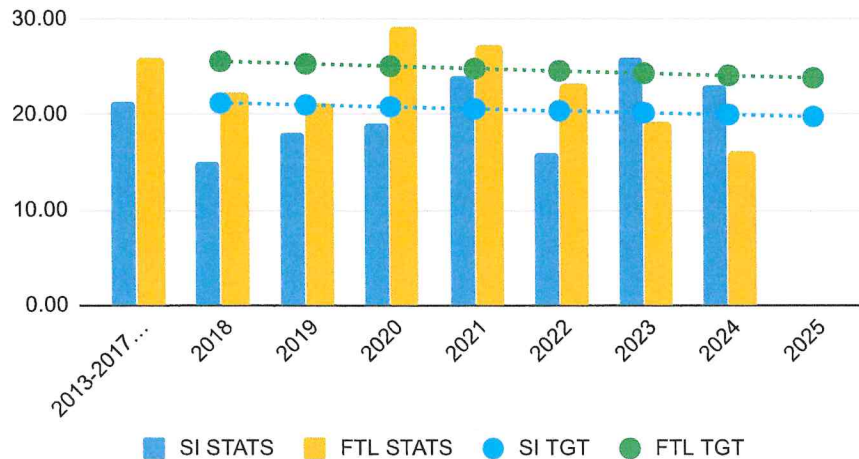

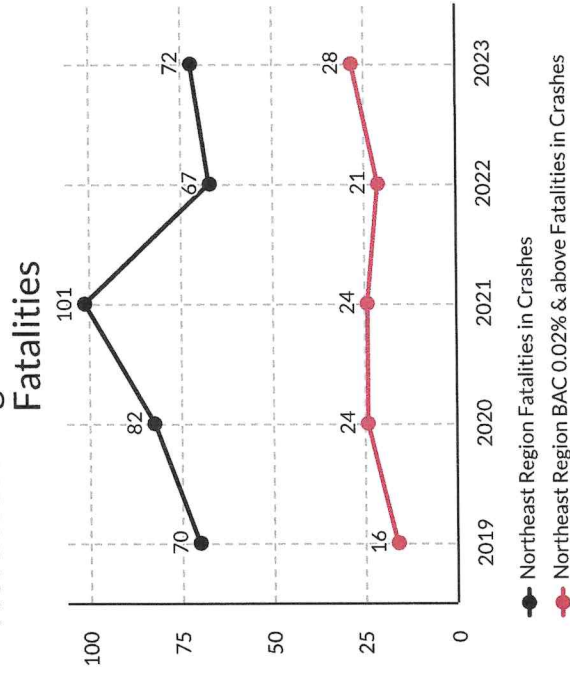

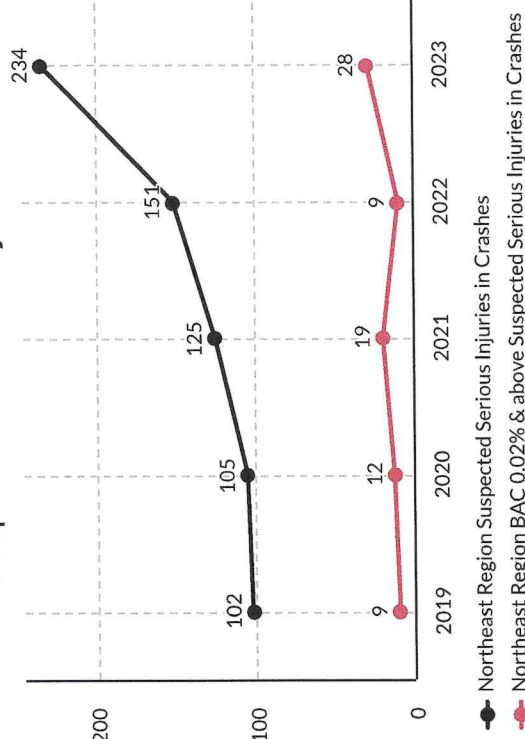

### Northeast Region BAC 0.02% Crash Fatalities



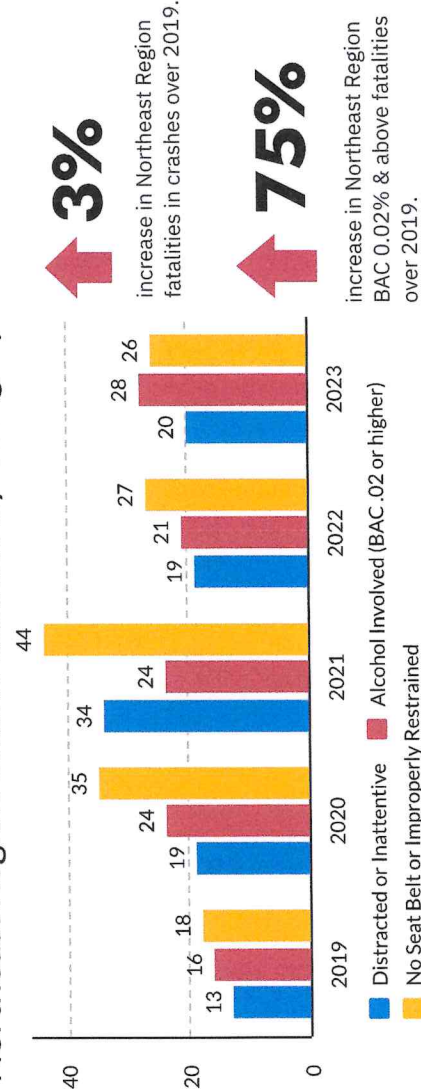
### Northeast Region BAC 0.02% Crash Suspected Serious Injuries



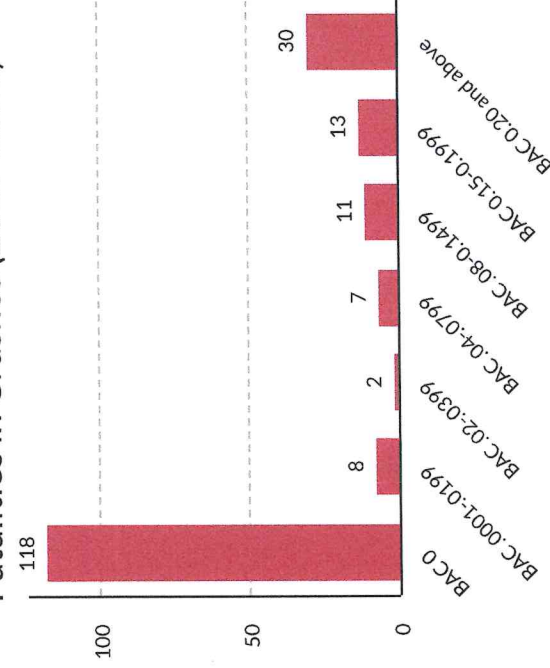

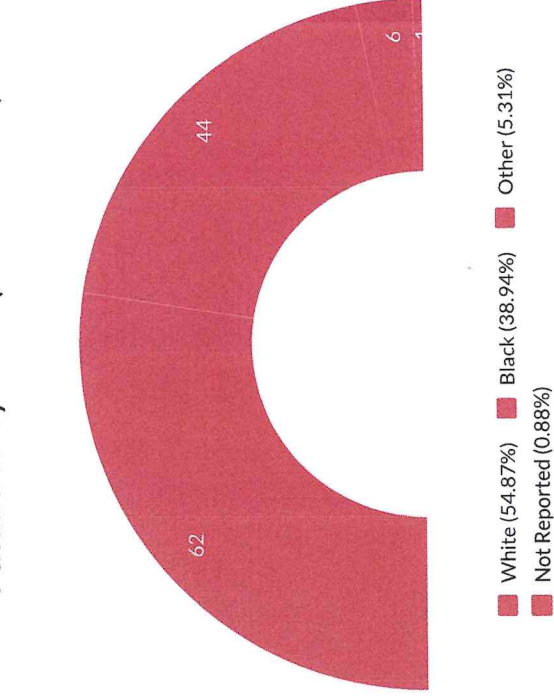
### Northeast Region Crash Fatalities by Category

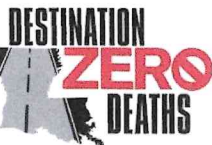
